NPS Junior Ranger Program

Social Studies is a great subject area which includes History and Geography. For United States History, there are several free resources available online which can be integrated into home education curricula. One of these includes the National Park Service ("NPS") <u>Junior Ranger Program</u>. This program is a badge program in which youth ages 5 to 13 can complete the following to receive a badge:

- 1. Complete Junior Ranger Booklet
- 2. Submit Booklet In-Person or by Mail

Booklets are available free of charge and can be acquired either in-person or online. Approximately 80 Junior Ranger Programs are available for submission by mail/online which makes for a great homeschool option. AEROSPACE CONNECTIONS IN EDUCATION:

<u>Aerospace Connections in Education ("ACE"</u>)* is a Curriculum program which contains lessons (with accompanying worksheets and/or manipulatives) for Grades Kindergarten to 6th. Each grade level has 21 lessons. Click the links below to view sample lessons for each grade level.

Upon the completion of 10 lessons within each applicable grade level, students receive a End of School Year ACE Program Completion Certificate.

AEROSPACE EDUCATION EXCELLENCE:

<u>Aerospace Education Excellence ("AEX")</u> is a Curriculum program which contains lessons (with accompanying worksheets and/or STEM Kits). AEX curricula focuses on specific areas of STEM (Physical Science, Earth Science, Model and Remote Controlled Aircraft; Astronomy; Advanced Math; Robotics; etc.) and many of the activities pair with the STEM Kits. The AEX Curriculum is offered as follows:

- 1. AEX I (grades K-5)
- 2. AEX II (grades 6-12)

Upon the completion of 6 lessons within each applicable grade level and attending a relevant 2 hour field trip, students receive an AEX Award Certificate.


